

GeoDesign, Inc. provided geotechnical engineering for previous site redevelopment concepts, which included three office buildings, a hotel, parking deck and conference center. Other proposed uses included a ferry terminal, boat museum, and retail shops.

We completed more than 30 borings and seven test pits on-site, and researched and compiled historic information on-site fills, construction, and subsurface information from other sources; including the Connecticut Department of Transportation.

Preliminary designs for foundations consisted of various types of piles, pressure injected footings, shallow foundations and mat foundations for buildings up to 14-stories high.
